We also created several Lego models to celebrate International Lego Day.



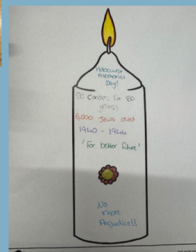
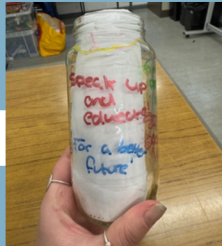
Group 6 Enrichment Day.

Holocaust Remembrance Day.

On 27th January, we learnt about Holocaust Memorial Day. It was the 80th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz- Birkenau, the largest Nazi concentration camp. We discussed how 6 million Jewish Men, Women and Children were killed during this time and how we cannot let this happen again. We learnt new keywords such as Holocaust and prejudice. The theme for this year was 80 candles for 80 years. We watched videos, and after discussions, learners were able to create their own candles; some used recycled jam jars, and others chose to create theirs on paper. Groups 1 & 6 lit candles and took part in a minutes silence.
